BURNSVILLE BLAZE HOCKEY CLINICS OFFERED AT BURNSVILLE ICE CENTER

Clinics Held Three Days a Week | June 11 – Aug. 3

From young Mites to the mighty Bantams, hockey players can enhance their skills this summer during Burnsville Blaze Hockey Clinics. Sessions will include stick skills, small area games on the ice and dryland training. Clinics will be held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from June 11 through Aug. 3.

Parents have the opportunity to choose from full-day and half-day options.

Full-Day Clinic

Mites and Squirts will receive more than 85 hours of training, Peewees over 90 and Bantams will exceed 109. All levels will be on the ice twice daily. Costs are based on the player's hockey level and range from \$700 - \$800 per person. All goalies are \$350.

A lunch option is not available this year. Participants must bring their own lunch.

Half-Day Clinic

All levels will receive more than 57 hours of instruction. Cost is \$550 per person, with a discounted rate of \$300 for all goalies.
