**OPEN HOUSE FOR PROPOSED LAKE MARION GREENWAY
REGIONAL TRAIL NORTH SEGMENT FEB. 22**

The Lake Marion Greenway is a 20-mile planned trail through Burnsville, Savage, Credit River Township, Lakeville and Farmington, with the intention of linking the Minnesota River to the Murphy Hanrehan Park Reserve.

The City of Burnsville and local area partners are currently working on both a north and south segment of the trail.

The **North Segment (Rose Bluff)** is in the final design stage. This half-mile segment runs from Kraemer Nature Preserve to Williams Drive. Construction is anticipated in fall 2018.

North Segment Public Open House Thursday, Feb. 22

The City of Burnsville will host a public open house on the *North Segment* in February. Those interested in the project are invited to ask questions and provide feedback.
