## **FILING FOR BURNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL CANDIDACY OPEN MAY 22 – JUNE 5**

*Two City Council Seats Up for Election*

Those interested in running for Burnsville City Council can **file an affidavit for candidacy beginning on Tuesday, May 22 through Tuesday, June 5.**

Affidavits are available through the City Clerk's Office at Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. during the filing period. (The City Clerk's office will accept affidavits until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5.)

To file for City Council, candidates must be eligible to vote in Minnesota, be at least 21 years of age when assuming office and a resident of Burnsville for at least 30 days. A \$20 filing fee will be assessed. Affidavits will not be accepted on Monday, May 28 when City offices are closed in observance of Memorial Day.

If necessary, a municipal primary election will be held on Tuesday, Aug. 14. A primary is held only if the number of candidates is one more than twice the number of individuals to be elected. For example, since there are two City Council positions on the November General Election ballot, five or more candidates would result in a municipal primary.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 6.
