Renovation

The building, part of the City of Burnsville's main campus at 100 Civic Center Parkway, was closed for a large-scale renovation and construction in June 2017. It was the first major renovation of the building since it was built in 1988.

This project – Phase I of the City's long-term facility improvement projects – consisted of completely gutting and reimagining the police department space. Specific changes include:

- Expanded training, briefing, interview and conference rooms
- Expanded workspace to reduce shared workstations
- Expanded and redesigned property and evidence storage/processing
- Accommodations for evolving technology and equipment
- Co-locating staff, storage and equipment based on related assignments
- Enlarging the public lobby, and creating a separate "release" lobby
- Addition of a 30-car squad garage
