**VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT FOR FLAG RAISING/LOWERING, MOBILE VOLUNTEER NETWORK,  
STORM DRAIN STENCILING**

The City of Burnsville is currently seeking volunteers to assist in storm drain stenciling, raising/lowering flags at public parks and facilities, and to be trained as part of Burnsville's Mobile Volunteer Network (MVN).

**Flag Volunteers**

Volunteers are needed to help raise and lower multiple flags at public locations during designated holidays and after proclamations. Volunteers will receive an email or text notification letting them know when and where flags need to be raised or lowered.

**Mobile Volunteer Network**

Participants in Burnsville's Mobile Volunteer Network (MVN) provide assistance and support to public safety officials during a disaster or special event. Duties include directing traffic; setting up perimeters, shelters and staging areas; missing persons searches; basic first aid and more.

**Storm Drain Stenciling**

Storm drains located on roadways drain directly into local ponds, rivers and lakes without pre-treatment. Volunteers are needed to help educate neighborhoods through storm drain stenciling. Using stencils and a map provided by the City, volunteers mark storm drains with messages like "Only Rain Down the Drain," or "Dump No Waste, Drains to Lake." Projects typically take a few hours.
