COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION MEETING ON THREE LEVEL III OFFENDERS WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 12 AT 6 P.M.

The Burnsville Police Department has been notified by the Minnesota Department of Corrections that three Level III (3) predatory offenders – MICHAEL LIDDELL (Aspen Drive and Parkwood Drive), ANTHONY JAMES BULMER (Aspen Drive and Parkwood Drive), and SHANGE MARTIN MCNEAL (River Woods Lane and Kennelly Road) – will be moving to Burnsville.

As allowed by Minnesota State Statute, the department will hold a community notification meeting on:

WHEN: Wednesday, Sept. 12, 2018 at 6 p.m.

LOCATION: Burnsville City Hall Lower Level Community Room, 100 Civic Center Parkway

The community meeting is open to the public, and will include representatives from the Burnsville Police Department, the Minnesota Department of Corrections, the Jacob Wetterling Foundation and Burnsville-Eagan-Savage School District 191.

It is not the intention of the Burnsville Police Department to increase fear in the community with this meeting. Rather, the purpose is to raise public awareness and provide sound information regarding predatory offenders. Released predatory offenders have always resided in Minnesota communities, and local law enforcement agencies cannot control or dictate where these individuals live or work.

Residents and businesses in the general vicinity of where the offenders are residing will receive a letter and invitation to the public meeting.
