## **KEALEY, WORKMAN ELECTED TO BURNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL**

Voter Turnout Nearly 80 Percent in Burnsville

Incumbent Dan Kealey and newcomer Vince Workman were both elected to the Burnsville City Council during the Nov. 6 General Election.

In the four-person race for two City Council seats, Kealey was the top vote getter. He was first elected to the City Council in 2006. This will be his fourth term.

Workman, who has served on Burnsville's Planning Commission, was elected to his first term on the Burnsville City Council.

Both will serve a four-year term that expires Dec. 31, 2022.

Burnsville's City Council Members and Mayor all serve "at large," and are elected by all voters within the City.

More than 28,000 votes were cast in Burnsville, which is nearly 80 percent of the City's registered voters. Of those, more than 8,200 were early/absentee votes – comprising just under 30 percent of the total votes cast.
